We would just need to organize the food and get the gyms reserved. Jen already has the main gym. We would just need to secure the aux gym. All proceeds from the concessions would be pure profit to UDBOP. They are expecting 18 color guards at this point and UDIP would then play an exhibition performance at the end of the show, while the scores are being tabulated. Jen would release the Drumline students by 4 PM. They would perform prior to their release, so they can support the Jazz show. Two of the Drumline Techs

are able to get Fraternity and Sorority volunteers to assist at this event. We would need food donations for both the WGI as well as the Jazz Fest.
